

It's time to think about lettering in the Fine Arts

REMEMBER:

This is for work in the fine arts in areas where you DO NOT earn a letter grade (just like in athletics, you do not earn letters based on classroom PE activity). **In order to receive a letter, you must fill out a form. This tells us that you wish to receive a letter.** Fill out the form even if you think you do not have enough points.

- Art projects done for a grade are NOT included. Work done outside of class is included. Painting a set could earn visual arts OR drama points ... **See Mrs Ellison or Mr Potter**
- Having a work selected for Artscape and working on Artscape set-up and takedown is considered...**see Mrs. VanderHaak**
- Attendance on MWTh and school-related concerts for Chamber Singers does NOT earn points for a student, but Chamber Singers' participation in a Sunday morning church service, for example, does earn points...**see Mrs. Tarter**
- Anyone who earns a grade on Tues and Fri in orchestra does not earn points. However, off-campus, non-CAJ sponsored performances would earn someone points....**see Mrs. Sasaki**
- Someone enrolled for Matsu class would not earn points for the class time; the extra Saturday and other work days would earn points....**See Mrs. Yamato.**

- If you were in a play this year, please just write that on the form. Points have been (or will be) assigned for your work, attitude, contribution, etc. If you worked on the stage crew, write this down as well...**see Ms Wood**
- Handbells out-of-school performances...**See Mr. Ponzani**
- Jazz Ensemble out-of-school performances...**See Mr. Ekstrand**
- Vocal Solo and Ensemble/Honor Choir/CS out-of-school performances...**see Mrs. Tarter**
- Instrumental Solo and Ensemble/Honor Band/Orchestra...**see Mr. Ekstrand/M. Sasaki**
- Recital pieces...see your supervising teacher.
- Math Field Day, Brain Bowl, Debate, Speech Contest ... **see your coach!**
- **NEW!!!! Worship Arts...see Mr. Hoad**
- If you have any questions, see **Mrs. Paris.**
